

"Come Away With Me" -Invitation to Retreat at Patris Corde

The practice of "coming away" with Jesus into the wilderness for a time of rest, renewal, and strengthening in vocation, for both priests and laity, is deeply rooted in Church history.

Creating Space for God: In many ways, the time at Patris Corde is meant to be like a personal "desert day": a step away from the noise of daily life to listen and pray. We hear from many of the Saints that when the faithful leave the world behind for a time—the daily routine and the distractions, good though they may besomething unique happens. The heart and soul can open to God with a receptivity that perhaps for our entire lives we unintentionally avoid. At Patris Corde there are no appointments, talks, gatherings, scheduled meetings, or time constraints—it's just one person, God, and His creation. Retreatants have the freedom to sleep, walk, rest, write, listen, and receive as He leads them.

Hermitage Retreat at Patris Corde: Because of this unique charism, we are dedicated to exclusively offering individual, hermitage-style retreats in sacred silence. Our non-group and non-preached retreats allow retreatants to simply "come away" with Jesus into the wilderness, let go of distractions, and receive from Him in silence and solitude. Spouses, friends, and groups who come to retreat at Patris Corde observe the same solitude and silence for the entirety of their retreat.

Grounds and Rhythm of Days: The retreat center rests on about 200 acres, is bordered by National Forest on several sides, and offers walking trails and open spaces designed to foster prayer. Outside of time in the hermitage, retreatants often spend their days walking the trails, visiting the Chapel of St. Joseph, and, if desired, speaking with their spiritual director either over the phone or on site once each day.

Hermitage and Amenities: Each hermitage is simple, comfortable, and fully furnished, oriented toward mountain views with large windows. Bread, cheese, fruit, coffee, and tea are provided, along with a small refrigerator single-burner range for light cooking. Many retreatants bring additional food.

Phones and Technology: We strongly encourage that cell phones be reserved for emergencies or spiritual direction only, allowing the heart to enter deeply into the stillness that can so easily become clouded by many cares.

Patris Corde Building Phases



Phase I - Private Opening

Completed September 23, 2023

- Completion of roads, utilities, and power systems
- Completion of first two hermitages
- Near completion of chapel
- Blessing of chapel by Archbishop Aquila and reservation of Blessed Sacrament

Phase II - Full Opening



Completion December 31st, 2025

- Completion of hermitages 3-6 with shower house
- Completion of water and septic system at chapel
- Construction of interim welcome building
- Hire grounds/maintenance staff member

Phase III - Move Toward Sustainability and Expand Awareness of Patris Corde's Mission

- Advance the mission of Patris Corde to renew and strengthen priests and laity in the Archdiocese of Denver and beyond
- Ensure excellence in retreat operations through attention to detail and personal connection with each retreatant
- Complete employee housing for one staff member to support retreatants on site (the majority of this cost has been covered by a special donation)
- Scale operating expenses to near 50% covered by suggested donations

Phase IV - Welcome Building Completion, Completion of Hermitages 7-11


- Convert current Ryan house to retreat center check-in/main building
